FOUNDER'S NOTES





The Historic Preservation Ordinance helps preserve the historical structures in Union City. So now the local historians will no longer worry that houses dating back to the 1920's in the Decoto and Alvarado areas will be demolished or significantly changed by owners as the homes age and need repairs. They are protected by the ordinance.

The Museum sends letters to the owners of the homes and buildings asking them if they want their homes or buildings to be preserved. This year we sent out 100 letters to the owners. Not all of them are interested in making their homes preserved. There were only two who responded to include their home or building in the Preservation Ordinance. We will continue to work on the preservation of these old homes and buildings.
