In 1998, the Museum's artifacts, donated by local citizens, were housed in the Union City Library. In 2001, the city leased an old fire station, a historical structure, to the Museum.

From those modest beginnings, guided by the objective of saving history, the Museum has grown into what it is today.

Through the years with great pride, the *Union City Historical Museum* helped the residents learn about our history. Our commitment is not only to educate our residents in history today, but to leave a legacy to our future generations.

20 YEARS OF SAVING HISTORY

For over 20 years, the *Union City Historical Museum* has been providing services to the community in way of historical education.

February 23, 2021 is the Museum's 20th year. The Museum displays artifacts collected from Union City residents, preserves historical documents and historical books, records oral history from people living in the community, and encourages preservation of historical homes and buildings.
